**What is Lip Sync?** A group of Eagle students pretend to sing and dance on stage in costume along to a song. Practices are scheduled by the parent representative of each group in order to coordinate a routine. Each group **MUST** have a parent representative.

**Who can participate?** Eagle students, in groups of 5 or more. Due to time and space limitations, **NO** group may be smaller than 5 participants. Big groups are highly encouraged! In the spirit of friendship and cooperation and to ensure that no student feels left out, **PLEASE ACCEPT STUDENTS INTO EXISTING GROUPS**. As parents we need to be very proactive in this area.

**How to sign up?** Form a group and designate a parent representative who will serve as the contact person. The parent representative will fill out 1 **FORM FOR THE ENTIRE GROUP** listing all of the group participants and the song choice, and send it into school. **Forms are available on the Eagle web site, in the main office or we can e-mail it.**

**How often is Lip Sync?** Lip Sync will be held every other year at Eagle Elementary.
