- Document Shredding/Paper Recycling***
- Hard Cover and Paperback Books for Reuse and Recycling**
- Electronics, Appliances & Scrap Metals for Recycling****
- Plastic Toys for Reuse and Recycling (*NEW THIS YEAR!*)**

NOTES: *Secure shredding limited to Town of Bethlehem residents and BCSD taxpayers with ID only. Shredding limit: 3 medium sized boxes per household. **COSTS:** **Electronics, appliances and scrap metals recycling is \$5/car donation to BCHS Environmental Club; All other drop-offs for reuse, recycling and shredding is FREE. **OTHER NOTES:** Books will be collected for reuse or recycling by *Grassroot Givers*; monetary donations will also be gratefully accepted. Fabric, yarn & sewing supplies will be collected for reuse by *Up-Stitch*. Plastic toys will be sorted for reuse or recycling.

CLOTHING, TEXTILES & FOOTWEAR

(See full list on right)

FABRIC, YARN, SEWING & KNITTING SUPPLIES

(*New this year!* See full list at right).

BOOKS (Hardcover and Soft Cover)

DOCUMENT SHREDDING (Limit of 3 med. sized boxes of documents. Bethlehem Residents and BCSD taxpayers only).

PLASTIC TOYS

(*New this year!* Hard plastic toys in OK condition only)

APPLIANCES, ELECTRONICS, METALS*:

- Appliances (large & small)
Air Conditioner, Dehumidifier, Refrigerator, Stove, Washer, Dryer, Microwave, Dishwasher, Toaster, Blender, Coffee Machine, Hot Plate, Etc.
- Audio / Visual Equipment
- Business Machines
- Cable or Satellite Receivers
- Cash Registers
- Cell Phones
- Circuit Boards
- Electronics: Computers, Keyboards, Mice, Printers, Copiers, Fax Machines. Scanners, Portable Digital Music Players, Servers (small scale), VCR, DVD, & DVR Players, Digital Converter Boxes, Hubs / Routers, Video Game Systems & Accessories, PDA's (personal digital assistant), Wiring & Cabling. Ink Cartridges
- Medical Electronics (EKG Machine, Heart Monitor)
- Metal Objects (Bikes, Swing Sets, Basketball Hoops, Grills, Metal Lawn Equipment, etc.)
- Personal Care Appliances – (Hair Dryer, Curling Iron, Walkers, Canes, Blood Pressure Monitors)

+++ ACCEPTABLE ITEMS +++

CLOTHING, TEXTILES & FOOTWEAR

ALL types of clothing, fabric, household textiles, stuffed animals, belts, hats, gloves, purses, bags, backpacks, footwear. **OK** if worn, stained, damaged, missing buttons or zippers, etc!

NO wet, smelly, or contaminated items.

NO carpets, mattresses, or loose stuffing.

FABRIC, YARN & SEWING SUPPLIES

Fabrics of all types and sizes, yarn, thread, sewing notions and tools, pins, buttons, elastic, trims, ribbon, lace, knitting needles, crochet hooks, sewing and knitting books, patterns.

NO mildew, pet or mothball odors.

xxx UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS xxx

NO TVs or Computer Monitors this year **due to increased costs!**



TVs/Monitors are still accepted at the Town Transfer Station.

NO Batteries; NO Fluorescent bulbs

NO Toxic or Hazardous Materials

NOTE: Many of these items can be disposed of at the Town of Bethlehem's Household Hazardous Waste Day, Saturday, May 6, 8 am—1 pm.
