Additional monies to be collected before trip – paid to school not to EF-

We estimate that this will be around \$250.00. This includes:

This will be non-refundable as we need to pay for the bus ahead of time and its price does not change even if you change your mind.

If our departure city remains as Albany, we will not have to collect money to charter a bus to the airport.
