	Spring Book Fair	March 5 – March 7	Set up, assist students during book fair (work book fair shifts), and/or clean up. The book fair is both during and after school hours. This has a flexible schedule and has volunteering opportunities for both during school and outside of school hours.
	Science Fair	March 19	Help plan/conduct the science fair, including: classroom visits, set-up & check in. Science-minded parents to act as "judges." This committee requires volunteering outside of school hours with some opportunity for volunteering during school hours. This event is in the evening.
	Hamagrael Community Garage Sale	April 13 (Saturday)	Coordinate donations from Hamagrael families, assist with This committee requires volunteering outside of school hours with some opportunity for volunteering during school hours. This event is in the evening.
	Teacher Appreciation Week	May 6-10	Assist with obtaining donations from grocery stores, purchasing breakfast items and set-up of breakfast for the teachers. Also assist with flower sales at the beginning of school on May 7. This has a flexible schedule and has volunteering opportunities for both during school and outside of school hours.

	Healthy Kids Week	May 6-10	Assist with various Healthy Kids Week Activities. This has a flexible schedule and has volunteering opportunities for both during school and outside of school hours.
	Art Show and Ice Cream Social	May 29	Assist with hanging artwork, obtaining supplies or volunteer to scoop. This committee requires volunteering outside of school hours. This event is in the evening.
	5th Grade Activities	Bake Sale, Pit Party & Moving up Ceremony	Assist with planning and running events. This is for fifth grade parents. Includes Craft Fair Bake sale coordination and planning the pit party & graduation. Also need one 4th grade parent to organize 4th grade volunteers to volunteer at graduation ceremony. The bake sale is in the fall so is over, but the pit party and graduation are events requiring a lot of help. Both the pit party and graduation are held at night and are not during school hours.
	Bus Driver Breakfast	June	Assist with food donation, set-up and cleanup of the breakfast. This has a flexible schedule and has volunteering opportunities for both during school and outside of school hours. This event is during school hours.
	Field Day	June 14	Assist with food, games, and other activities at field day. This event requires a lot of volunteers. This event is during school hours and volunteering is during the event.

If your child(ren) will remain at Hamagrael for the 2019-20 school year, please consider volunteering for one of the following early fall events. Some committees start planning before kids are back at school.

	Fall Family Picnic	2 <sup>nd</sup> or 3 <sup>rd</sup> Sunday in September	Assist chairs by securing raffle items in August & early September. Set up and organize raffle at picnic. Help with food (grill, organize, monitor food), sell raffle tickets, set up and clean-up of picnic. This is outside school hours.
	School Pictures	September	Organize and line up students, help with grooming, check student envelopes and assist photographer. This is during school hours.
	Halloween Party - General Party & Bake Sale	Oct. 25	Assist with planning, coordinating entertainment, set-up and/or clean-up and bake sale. This event is at night, volunteering is outside of school hours.
	Halloween Party - Arts and Crafts	Oct. 25	Help chair with arts and crafts ideas, manning tables to assist students and set-up/clean-up. Volunteering is outside of school hours.
	Halloween Haunted House	Oct. 25	Help with Haunted House planning and execution, set-up and take-down. Volunteering is outside of school hours and in weeks prior to the event.
