We were disappointed with how communication was handled around the drone that appeared over the playground during recess. There was a lot of time for rumors to spread before parents were notified in an official capacity.

There is no support for gifted and talented students at the elementary level. The school lunch options are all highly processed foods with many ingredients, most of them unpronounceable. The school staff should be ashamed of what they are feeding the children.

Regarding healthy food options, I think there are enough options; however, there are no options for Muslim, Hindu, and other community children. That would be great if there were halal and more veggie options(particularly labeled so these students can see) for the students.

Each teacher should send a weekly update out to parents electronically with both what they've done that week and what's on the docket coming up. Parents always have to be reactive to the classroom instead of proactive, and sometimes we only find out about things they've learned or are doing months later from our kid. There is not an attempt to have true inclusivity in every classroom — there are still racist books and whitewashed curriculum. The smaller class sizes are great for individual



attention but I wish there were more attempts made to offer different levels of curriculum, even if that meant having to coordinate with other teachers and split classes up to do it. In general it feels very much like "isn't everything so great" ... of course it is, if there's no way for anyone to communicate otherwise!

Let kids from more than one class participate in the school play.
