Places to Get Food

Bethlehem Central School District

Free breakfast and lunch for all students regardless of income level, no qualification needed. Weekend Backpack Program: Sends food home via a backpack during weekends and school breaks. If you want your student to participate contact your school nurse.

Ravena Coeymans School District

Free breakfast and lunch for all students regardless of income level, no qualification needed. Weekend Backpack Program: currently at capacity, but if your student needs support reach out to Doug Porter, food services director dporter@rcscsd.org

Little Free Pantry @ Town Hall

445 Delaware Ave, Delmar – has some food items at all hours, access at your convenience – run by the Girl Scouts

Blessings Box @ St Thomas the Apostle Church Parking Lot

35 Adams Place (in parking lot behind the church) has some food items at all hours, access at your convenience (note: it is next to a compost shed and is clearly labeled)

Ways To Help

Volunteer

All Locations listed above run on volunteer support. They all need help. Contact one nearest you and see how you can give a few hours.

1

Gift Cards

Gift cards in \$25, \$50, and \$100 denominations to grocery stores or Wal Mart are needed at all locations.

2

Monetary Donations

The Regional Food Bank provides items to many of the above food pantries (but not all) - You can donate to them to for regional support. But to support a local pantry it is best to donate to them directly.

Each individual location can take monetary donations. Call to coordinate. Most have easy links to donate and may also have drop boxes for checks.

Non-Perishable Food Items

Most Pantries need non-perishable foods for their shelves - although some do have some fridge and freezer space. Remember to get items that can be eaten without adding additional ingredients.

Toiletries, Pet Food

Most Pantries also accept and distribute toiletries, shampoo/conditioner, deoderant, etc... Also pet food (Patty's Place also distributes pet food).
