<b>Conceptual/Personal Knowledge</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Understands basic cause/effect, but lacks complete understanding</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Demonstrates basic understanding that actions have associated consequences</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Begins to discriminate between reality and fantasy</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Discriminates between food/non-food items</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Identifies own and others' gender</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Knows first and last name</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Knows his/her age</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Understands concept of same/different</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Engages in make-believe play and symbolic play</li> </ul>				
<b>Critical Thinking</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Attempts to solve problems visually or verbally</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Interested in exploring and learning – asks many “why” questions</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Names similarities and differences between objects</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Still has difficulty with making predictions</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Distinguishes between writing and other visual marks</li> </ul>				
<b>Math Concepts</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Understands the concepts of one and two</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Counts up to 5 objects with 1:1 correspondence</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Matches colors</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Matches shapes, colors, and sizes</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Matches objects to their feature, function, or category</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Names at least 3-4 colors</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Begins to recognize simple patterns (ABAB)</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Understands basic concepts of time (eat breakfast in the morning, go to bed at night)</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Understands basic quantitative/temporal concepts and opposites: big/little, fast/slow, long/short,)</li> </ul>				

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<p><b>Pre-Literacy Concepts</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Recognizes his/her name</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Recognizes letters in his/her name</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Knows some letters</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Retells simple stories</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Use pictures to make inferences about book content</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Answers some questions about text read aloud</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Understands that print can be read</li> </ul>				
<p><b>Attention</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Sustains attention to a large group activity for ten minutes given prompts</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Recognizes environmental sounds</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Filters low level noise to attend to speaker</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Sustains attention to short books</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Sustains attention to speaker during short conversations</li> </ul>				
<p><b>Memory/Organization</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Recalls events from yesterday</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Retells simple experiences</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Repeats up to 6-8 word sentences</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Remembers where he/she left items</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Knows where common objects are kept/can be found at home/in the classroom</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Knows basic daily routine</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Follow simple 2-3 step directions</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Follows complex 1-step directions</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Knows simple rhymes</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Keeps track of/collects personal items (e.g. gets and puts on jacket and shoes when told it is time to go outside, gets jacket and backpack from cubby at end of school day)</li> </ul>				
<p><b>Visual/Spatial/Perceptual/Sensory</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Matches objects to pictures</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Recognizes basic environmental sounds</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Able to complete 4-12 piece puzzles</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Imitates actions of others</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Matches objects by shape, color, size</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Matches 3 and 4 block patterns</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Describes properties of objects by using senses (color, scent, sound, texture)</li> </ul>
